ABOUT RIO TINTO

The Rio Tinto Group are a British-Australian multinational firm founded in 1873. The company is one of the biggest metals and mining organisations across the globe.

The Group has numerous subsidiaries in countries around the world (partly and wholly owned) - the subsidiary in South Africa is Richards Bay Minerals (RBM). RBM are 74% owned by Rio Tinto and are producers of ilmenite.

ABOUT THE BURSARY

Each year 4 to 8 students are awarded bursaries for the duration of their tertiary studies. The bursary covers the full cost of study fees for a 1 to 4 year period.

Bursaries are awarded to students in the following fields of study:
