PROGRAMME OVERVIEW 2023

The Xylem SA Trust is a development trust committed to "Solving Water" by creating opportunities to support and develop innovative and smart technology solutions to meet the world's water, wastewater and energy needs.

The Trust engages in endeavours that will support the development of underserved South African citizens and entities in, amongst others, educational financial assistance and scholarships. The Trust calls on all eligible undergraduate and postgraduate students in South Africa to apply for their fully funded scholarships.

Programme participant criteria

Individuals who meet the following criteria, may apply:

- Black South African citizens (HDI's)
- Valid South African Identity documentation
- 35 years of age or younger
- Planning to, or registered to study at a recognized South African tertiary institution for the 2023 academic year;
- Must not be receiving any other bursaries, including NSFAS

Consideration will be given to objective merit and need. Preference will be given to applicants from rural areas, youth and women.

Which fields of study are eligible for funding?

The shifting nature of tertiary study in technical vocations reflects the rapidly evolving nature of the needs of the market and the planet, with new technologies and approaches constantly emerging and changing the way we understand and manage water resources.

This dynamic environment requires students to be adaptable and flexible in their learning, as well as highly motivated and committed to staying up-to-date with the latest developments and innovations in the field. Ultimately, the ability to stay current and adapt to new technologies and approaches will be essential for those pursuing careers in water science and related fields.

In appreciation of this context the trustees of the Xylem SA Trust will consider applications for studies in technical fields that are water-related and/or linked to the servicing of the scarce skills gap in South Africa.

Fields of study to be considered include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Water-related and water infrastructure fields such as Engineering
- Hydrogeology
- Construction related courses
- Water Quality

Which year of study should the applicant be in?

All students who meet the above criteria can apply, regardless of year of study, at undergraduate as well as post-graduate level.

What is included in the bursary?

Tuition, textbooks, stipend/subsistence allowance, student accommodation and student support.

- Proof of residential address
- Parents or guardians ID documents (certified copies)



- Parents or guardians' proof of income (latest payslips if employed, affidavit if unemployed, SASSA confirmation if receiving a grant) (certified copy)
- If parents or guardian is married, divorced or deceased attached certified copies of the relevant documents
- Parents or guardians divorce certificate, if divorced (certified copy)
- Parents or guardian's death certificates, if deceased (certified copy)
